the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act, all meetings of the Committee are open to the public. Individuals may appear before the Committee to discuss items not on the agenda; however, the Committee can neither discuss nor take official action on these items at the time of the same meeting [Government Code sections 11125, 11125.7(a)].
