## NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY REGULATORY ACTION READOPTION

**Subject:** Procedures to hold combative sporting events when an infectious disease causes a State of Emergency

## **To All Interested Parties:**

The California State Athletic Commission (Commission) hereby finds that an emergency, as defined in Government Code section 11342.545, continues to exsist. As such, the Commission finds that immediate action to readopt the Commission's amended regulations is required to maintain essential health and safety practices for the Commission's licensees. The Commission specifically finds that a readoption of the emergency regulations is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health and safety, and general welfare of the citizens of California.

Government Code section 11346.1 (a)(2) requires that, at least five (5) working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), the adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. After submission of the proposed emergency to OAL, OAL shall allow interested persons five (5) calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6.

The Commission plans to file the Emergency Rulemaking Package with OAL at least five (5) working days from the date of this notice. If you wish to comment on the Finding of Emergency or the proposed emergency regulation, both the Commission and OAL must receive comments within five (5) calendar days of the Commission's filing with OAL. During an emergency filing of proposed regulations, it is the Commission's discretion to respond to any public comment received in the five (5) day public comment period.
